

In the beginning God made Heaven and earth – how? High-energy light is like moist air that, when it cools down, forms clouds, etc.

Light is the seven spirits of God and God is light. Rev. 5:6.

God lost sovereignty on earth due to the snake in paradise and through sin residing in man.

The Devil wanted to be like God and was hurled from the hill of God – in the same way he incited man to be like God (Gen 3:5 – For God knows that when you hear of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil).

And so man was banished from the land of God.

God had to regain sovereignty and for that purpose he sent his son - Luke 19:12.

He could not recreate us – but he could have us reborn and he could buy us. Story of boy who made his toy car and bought it.

Now we were His twice over.

In Rev.19:6 we see the moment when God accepted this sovereignty.

Also look at Rev, 12:10 – Now have come the salvation and the power and the kingdom of our God, and the authority of Christ.

For the accuser of our brothers, who accuses them before our God day and night, has been hurled down. This sovereignty restores the Lord Jesus to the Father.

1 Cor. 15:24-26 - Then the end will come, when he hands over the kingdom to God the Father after he has destroyed all dominion, authority and power.

For he must reign until he has put all his enemies under his feet. The last enemy to be destroyed is death.

His son was in actual fact he himself who came to earth.

Isa. 9:6 - For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counsellor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

And Col. 2:9 – For In Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form.

A kingdom has levels of authority. There are kings, princes, rules or rulers of the world. We will be kings because we will rule with Him as kings for 1000 years.

Thereafter the Lord Jesus once again returns the authority to God. At the moment we (who are in Him) therefore have the authority to act on behalf of God.

We have to accept and respect authority, because it was instituted by God.

Hebr. 13:17 - Obey your leaders and submit to their authority. They keep watch over you as men who must give an account. Obey them so that their work will be a joy, not a burden, for that would be of no advantage to you.

We should also not rebel against God because once we have given our will over to Him, we cannot take it back.

No battle can be won in this way.
